THESE DISTRICT CONDITIONS OF PLAY APPLY FOR ALL DISTRICT "CHAMPION OF CLUB CHAMPIONS" EVENTS

- Singles Championship:** Current Club Singles Champion. Games shall be 25 shots up.
- Pairs Championship:** Current Club Pairs Champions. Games played over 21 ends.
- Two Bowl Triples Championship:** Current Club Two Bowl Triples Champions. Games played over 28 ends.
- Three Bowl Triples Championship:** Current Club Three Bowl Champions. Games played over 21 ends.
- Fours Championship:** Current Club Fours Champions. Games played over 21 ends.

"B" GRADE CHAMPION OF CLUB CHAMPIONS.

- "B" Grade Singles Championship:** Current "B" Grade Club Singles Champion. Games shall be 25 shots up.
- "B" Grade Pairs Champion:** Current "B" Pairs Club Champions. Games shall be played over 21 ends.

PLEASE NOTE :

Any player who has won a Club Championship Singles or a Club "B" Grade Singles in a previous year is not eligible to play in any "B Grade" District Champion of Club Champions event.

SENIOR SINGLES CHAMPION OF CLUB CHAMPIONS.

- Senior Singles Championship:** Current Senior Singles Club Champion. Games shall be 25 shots up.

(To be classed as a "Senior" a player must be 65 years of age or older as at 31 December prior to the current championships.)

NOMINATIONS FOR DISTRICT CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

Participating clubs must nominate and name their players before 6pm on the Sunday prior to the event being held. A Club that nominates and then withdraws without contacting the District Secretary may be fined \$100.00.

PROVISION OF UMPIRES and MARKERS

For Championship Singles, Pairs and Fours, host clubs are responsible for the provision of National Accredited Umpires (preferably non – playing) whose name will be announced before play commences. For other events, a competent person is to be appointed if an accredited umpire is not available. Clubs hosting singles events must supply competent markers for each rink.
